PART TIME/SEASONAL MOSQUITO CONTROL TECHNICIAN
JOB DESCRIPTION

- Would be responsible for surveillance missions within the county.
- Duties would include but are not limited to, setting up and collecting CDC light traps, performing landing rate counts, identification and counting of collected specimens, etc.
- Sending specimens in for testing at various diagnostic labs throughout the State.
- Performing spray missions in accordance with collected data and State regulations.
- Performing source reduction techniques throughout the county as deemed appropriate by the Mosquito control coordinator.
- Assist in developing mitigation techniques and strategies based upon collected data for specific mosquito species in our area.
- Assist infield related experiments such as resistance testing within the local mosquito population.
- Assist with the maintenance and up keep of various types of equipment used in the local mosquito control program.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

MUST HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, MUST HAVE THE ABILITY TO READ AND WRITE AND PERFORM BASIC MATHEMATICAL CALCULATIONS. MUST HAVE VALID FLORIDA DRIVERS LICENSE. MUST BE FAMILIAR WITH THE PROBLEM MOSQUITOES IN OUR AREA. MUST BE WILLING TO WORK SOME NIGHTS AND WEEKENDS AS NEEDED. MUST HAVE THE ABILITY TO READ AND UNDERSTAND THE LAWS, RULES, AND ORDINANCES THAT GOVERN THE LOCAL MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM. MATURE JUDGEMENT NEEDED TO BALANCE AUTHORITY AND THE OBLIGATION TO BE COURTEOUS TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC ESPECIALLY IN SENSITIVE SITUATIONS. MUST SHOW A WILLINGNESS TO OBTAIN EDUCATION AS IT RELATES TO THE DUTIES OF THE LOCAL MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM. MUST BE WILLING TO SUBMIT TO A PRE EMPLOYMENT DRUG SCREENING.
