AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MADISON COUNTY, FLORIDA PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES WITH THE AUTHORITY TO HOLD HEARINGS AND ASSESS FINES AGAINST VIOLATORS OF THE CODES AND ORDINANCE IN FORCE IN THE COUNTY PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 162.01-162.13, FLORIDA STATUTES, THE "LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD ACT"; PROVIDING FOR INTENT; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE SELECTION, QUALIFICATIONS, TERMINATION AND COMPENSATION OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES; PROVIDING FOR THE POWERS AND JURISDICTION OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES; PROVIDING FOR A CLERK; PROVIDING FOR THE COUNTY ATTORNEY TO REPRESENT THE COUNTY BEFORE THE SPECIAL MAGISTRATE; PROVIDING FOR CODE INSPECTORS AND ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES; PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT OF HEARINGS; PROVIDING THE POWER TO SUBPOENA; ESTABLISHING FINES, COSTS OF REPAIR AND LIENS; PROVIDING FOR THE DURATION OF THE LIEN; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF FINAL ORDERS; PROVIDING THE RIGHT TO APPEAL; PROVIDING THE PROCEDURES FOR NOTICE; PROVIDING THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE ARE SUPPLEMENTARY TO OTHER REMEDIES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES: PROVIDING FOR TRANSITION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The public purpose to be served by the proposed ordinance is serving the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the County.
